A Two-Page Fact Sheet	Mayan families enjoy food security, health and improved nutrition. Imagine you are the parents of children who are chronically ill and malnourished. If you live in rural Guatemala, you are likely a subsistence farmer, illiterate, and dropped out of school by the second grade. With less land to farm than your father and grandfather, your November harvest doesn't provide for your family for 12 months. The shortage of food and chronic ill health retard your children's physical and mental development, reducing their ability to attend and succeed in school—hindering them from leading prosperous and productive lives as adults.	
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A Donor Presentation	Donors are looking for solid project concepts and sound implementation plans that will provide the kind of project impact necessary for fulfilling their mission. Many donors will be glad to have an introductory meeting with you, but it is essential to identify donors that have similar missions to yours. In the meeting share your fact sheet with the donor; if your project concept will help them accomplish their missions and goals, then there is room for discussion. Donors give excellent feedback because they have seen so many projects. Encouraging donor input forges partnerships and ownership.
